It also manages a great depth of color and really variety. It's not much of a looker, but it's not of the greatest interest when it comes to the projector, so if it has a bit of utilitarian style on it you can probably forgive it. The fan can also be a little loud in operation, but the reality is that the image quality easily makes up for small disadvantages. Pocket-lintsqurriel_widget_233108You can pick up a standard W2000 if you want to save a little money and still get a great experience, but we like the extra brightness that the Plus model brings to the table, which is so key to enjoying your projection experience. This is a super projector, even managed to pack capable loudspeakers for a great all-round package. It's also easy to set up and works nicely if you're planning a game as well – smoothing mode works nicely for all the Call of Duty: Warzone sessions you'd like to set up. Amazonsquirrel_widget_233133That said that we have focused more on the gaming side of things for our final pick – after all, for a large number of people image quality is most important when they are playing games, although not many projectors aim directly at this market. This model from Optoma does just that, with impressive results. The key here is the lack of input lag, which is very short for the projector at this price point, and means that you can play with full response, which other competitors will noticeably miss.
